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31-4 After reading the EA regarding the proposed lease at Coralville Lake/Camp Daybreak, I believe the EA underestimated the environmental impact the proposed camp will have on the surrounding area and the financial burden the camp will place on Johnson County and other service providers in the area.

- 13-8 1. The structures proposed at the camp would not be adequately sustained by the well and wastewater system proposed.
- 22-23 2. The Scales Bend Road would inevitably need to be replaced at county taxpayer expense. By the limited nature of people who will use the camp this creates a situation of many people paying for a cost created by the relatively few county people attending the camp. Johnson County taxpayers would pay for a new road because of a federal government decision. Will the federal government help pay for the new road?
- 3. The other infrastructure services of county ambulance and sheriff and North Liberty police and fire protection would be stretched to a point they may need to expand their employees or equipment. Again county or local taxpayers would be paying for something few of them would use because of a federal government decision.
