**Description**

Enbridge Pipeline (FSP), L.L.C., is proposing to build an oil pipeline from Flannigan, IL (near Chicago) to Cushing, Oklahoma. This will require the Rock Island District to issue a real estate easement to cross Federally-managed lands at the Mississippi River. To assess the environmental impacts of the river crossing, the District required Enbridge to prepare an environmental assessment (EA).
