MONTHLY PUBLIC NOTICE
CEMVR-OD-P

Date: November 21, 2008
Sections 10 and 404

1. Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403) prohibits the unauthorized construction or alteration of any navigable water of the United States. The construction of any structure in, under, or over any navigable water of the United States, the excavation from or depositing of material in such waters, or the accomplishment of any other work affecting the course, location, conditions, or capacity of such waters is unlawful unless the work has been recommended by the Chief of Engineers and authorized by the Secretary of the Army.

2. Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344) authorizes the Secretary of the Army, acting through the Chief of Engineers, to issue permits, after notice and opportunity for public hearing, for the discharge of dredged or fill material into the waters of the United States at specified disposal sites.

3. During the period 1 October 2008 through 31 October 2008 the following applications for Department of the Army permits were processed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Rock Island District, Rock Island, Illinois. The following abbreviations are used because of space considerations.


4. Section 404 processing was completed on the following Rock Island District Army Corps of Engineers projects.
