- The wetlands are contiguous to an unnamed tributary channel ¼ mile upstream from Burr Oak Creek. The applicant described the channel as being 2 feet wide and one foot deep in a permanent grass pasture. Total drainage area is 1.2 square miles. The NRCS Soil Survey describes the soils as lying in upland drainageways and small stream floodplains. Viewing 2002 and 2004 GIS aerial photos, 1990 USDA Aerial Photo, and RAMS-GIS Ortho photo, the channel appears to lack OHW indicators.
- In addition, the applicant stated the channel on the neighboring farm to the south (downstream) was tilled and a grassed waterway graded approximately eight years ago. Aerial photography confirms that ½ mile of tributary channel on two downstream farms in the SW¼ of Section 14, T97N, R45W, is presently grassed waterway lacking OHW indicators.
