The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Rock Island District (District) has enclosed a copy of the Environmental Assessment (EA) entitled, *Flanagan South Pipeline Project Environmental Assessment Report Mississippi River Crossing*, dated November 2013. The District is interested in your review and comments regarding the alternative analysis for this project. The District will finalize the EA after you have had a chance to comment.

The District proposes to issue the Enbridge Pipelines (FSP) L.L.C a right-of-way easement to cross approximately 3,160 feet of land managed by the District located along the Mississippi River in Adams County, Illinois and Lewis County, Missouri. The Flanagan South Pipeline Project (Project) is an independent project beginning at Enbridge's Flanagan, Illinois Terminal and ending at the Enbridge Cushing, Oklahoma terminal. The Project pipeline route is approximately 593.0 miles long. This EA addresses only the impacts associated with the pipeline construction on federally-managed lands and the river crossing.
