Nagawicka Lake is located within the city limits of Delafield, in Waukesha County, Wisconsin. The village of Nashota also exists along the lake. The project site is approximately 30 miles west of Milwaukee.

## Description

The City of Delafield requested assistance in Jan 2004 through the Section 206 program for the restoration of Nagawicka Lake. Nagawicka Lake is on the Bark River, which flows into the Rock River, and eventually into the Upper Mississippi River. The lake is 917 acres, with a mean depth of 36 feet. However, some parts of the lake are experiencing significant sedimentation. Delafield requests assistance regarding the following issues:

- Sedimentation within the lake
- Silt runoff from within the watershed
- Invasive species eradication: zebra mussels and Eurasian milfoil
- Improved storm water control
- Improved diversity within the lake fishery.
