Description

Under authority of Public Law 84-99, during flood emergencies the Corps of Engineers may provide tribal, state and local communities with flood fight supplies and equipment. USACE Districts maintain stocks of flood fight supplies and equipment based on historical usage patterns and forecasted conditions to provide for district-wide flood events. The National Flood Fight Materiel Center (NFFMC) at the Rock Island District was established to supplement district warehoused levels, provide cost-effective surge and replenishment support, and reestablish district stocks during recovery operations. The NFFMC maintains baseline inventories and IDIQ contracts with capabilities to provide flood fight materials support to districts throughout the Continental United States. The NFFMC can provide the following support: · Sandbags · Polyethylene Sheeting · Large (Airlift Capable) Sandbags · Expedient Flood Fight Products (e.g. HESCO Bastion Flood Barriers) · Flood Pumps (diesel and PTO driven) · Technical support

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
