Status

This project is being accomplished through a partnership between the Wisconsin DNR and DMA, USGS, National Weather Service and Corps of Engineers. Certain components of the project have already been completed. The Corps' role will be to carry out HEC-RAS model simulations using existing DNR models and supporting final report development. Other agencies will be responsible for: collecting and assembling data; mapping; and product finalization and distribution.

Description

The development and web-based sharing of flood inundation maps for 5 reaches of the Rock River located in Jefferson, Dodge and Rock Counties, WI. These five reaches encompass approximately 31.8 river miles. Flood inundation maps are critical to flood emergency management planning and implementation as well as many other flood risk reduction and floodplain management initiatives and actions. This project is consistent with and supports the goals of the State of Wisconsin's Hazard Mitigation Plan.
